Spirit Week Dress Code Guidelines

The following guidelines apply throughout the entire spirit week:

- Every outfit for each themed day must be CCS appropriate! You know the standards for modesty, so please follow them.
- NO shorts, leggings, or tights will be permitted.
- Jeans and athletic pants must fit appropriately and follow dress code.
- Face paint or temporary hair color are allowed.
- Hoods on hoodies must not be up.
- Ball caps/hats appropriate to the theme of the day are fine.
- No chapel dress is required on Thursday.
- If you choose not to participate, you must wear regular school uniform.

Overall, when choosing an outfit each day, the dress code policies of modesty and appropriate fit must be of primary concern. Be creative within those parameters. Most importantly – HAVE FUN!!

Monday 1/6/2020: Pajama Day, Favorite Sports Team Day, Intellect Day, Tourist Day, or Disney Day.



- a. *Pajama Day* - Students may wear pajamas.
- modest (not too tight or too loose)
 - oversized t-shirts/night shirts with pants may be worn
 - no nightgowns or pajama shorts
 - Slippers are permitted in class, but shoes must be worn to school,



outside for recess or walking between buildings, and for P.E.



- b. *Favorite Sports Team Day* - Students should wear a jersey, t-shirt, hat, bandana, hoodie, etc from your favorite sports team or dress up like their mascot. Example: Oriole Bird, Raven, etc.

- c. *Intellectual Day* – Dress as a sophisticated, intelligent person would dress.



- d. *Tourist Day* – Where would you like to visit? Dress like you would if you were a tourist there. For example, dress like you are going to Hawaii!



- e. *Disney Day* – Dress like your favorite school appropriate Disney character.



Tuesday 1/7/2020: Class Color Wars

Class Color wars- Students should wear as much of their assigned color as possible. Example: white sweatpants, white t shirt, white hoodie, white socks, white sneakers, white hat, white headband, white face paint, white gloves, etc. If you do not have many items, borrow from siblings or friends, and just do as much as you can.

Wednesday 1/8/2020: Squad Day/Twin Day, Clash/Wacky Wednesday, Emotion Day, or Inside Out Day.

- a. *Twin Day* – Get a partner and dress exactly alike.
- b. *Squad Day* – As a spin-off of Twin Day, students team up with friends to dress in a fun squad theme (pre-approved by their homeroom teacher). Examples: Crayon Box-someone be each color, Star Wars-someone be each character, 3 Stooges, etc.



- a. *Clash Day/Wacky Wednesday* – Students mix and match and clash as much as possible.
- b. *Emotion Day* – Dress reflecting your favorite emotion.
- c. *Inside Out Day* – Wear your clothes inside out.



Thursday 1/9/2020: Circle of Life Day, Holiday Day, Meme Day, Favorite Food Day, Biblical or Historical Character Day.



- a. *Circle of Life Day* – Students can dress up to represent their favorite stage of life from the cradle to the old age. (baby, child, teen, young adult, middle age, elderly, ancient, etc.) (See note under Spirit Week guidelines.)



- b. *Holiday Day* – Students can dress to represent their favorite holiday. Examples: dress like a Christmas tree or present

- c. *Meme Day* – Dress like your favorite meme.

- d. *Favorite Food Day* – Dress like your favorite food.

- e. *Biblical or Historical Character Day* – Dress like your favorite Biblical or historical character.



Friday 1/10/2020: Patriot Pride Day

Show as much Patriot Pride as possible!

- Jeans or athletic pants are acceptable.
- Wear red, white, and blue.
- Socks and shoes are required.
- Face paint, hair ribbons, and hair paint are allowed.



Have some fun and show our school spirit! Come as our patriot mascot or a famous patriot! (Toy guns should not be brought to school.)

Monday 1/13/2020: Pun Day/ Dress like a Teacher/Career Day, Hill Billy Day.

NOTE: The Seniors will be serving this day.

- Pun Day* – Dress appropriately to show a pun. Example: Social butterfly (dress like a butterfly and have social media logos attached to your shirt). Holy cow (dress like a cow and wear a halo).
- Teacher/Career Day* – Dress like your favorite teacher or as you would for a career.
- Hill Billy Day* – Dress like a hill billy



Dress Up Winners

- Winners for most creative in each category will be chosen each day (1/6 – 1/10), and points will be awarded to each homeroom toward earning the CCS Spirit Stick.
- **Note: Your class may want to talk and plan who is dressing in which category so that all the categories are represented for potential points.**
- The class will also earn points based on the percentage of class participation.

Class Spirit:

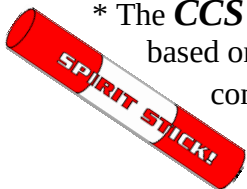


1. *Wall Decoration Contest:* As always, each class will be responsible for decorating a designated wall of the gym.
 - Tape is not to be used on the walls. All posters need to be hung with sticky tack or Command hooks.
 - Thursday, January 9 by 1:00 p.m. is the deadline for these decorations.
 - Everything should support CCS and not oppose Mountain View. Keep it positive and appropriate. Walls are decorated by grade level.
2. *Locker Decorating Contest:* The class will receive points for having the most individual students (percentage) who decorate their locker to display school spirit.
 - Do not use tape or anything that will harm lockers. Use sticky tack or Command hooks, instead.
 - Lockers should be decorated by the end of lunch on Friday.
3. *Door Decoration Contest:* Each class will decorate their door and should try to incorporate the themes (for the week/days). Doors should be decorated by noon on Friday, January 10. Please do not cover the window in the door. Doors are decorated by each Homeroom.
4. *Class Cheer:* Each class will develop an appropriate class cheer for them to cheer at the Pep Rally. It must be approved by the homeroom teacher.

****Note: The walls, doors, cheer, and lockers will be judged on**

2. Creativity
3. Quality

* The **CCS School Spirit Stick** will go to the class who has the highest score for the week based on their daily dress up participation, wall, lockers and door decorations, and class competitions. The class who wins the **CCS Spirit Stick** will have a dress down day on Tuesday, January 14.
