GUIDELINES 2020-2021

Officers and Representatives

The CCS Student Council will be comprised of elected class representatives from the middle and high school students. There will be two class representatives from each grade in the middle and high school. Individual classes will vote for their own class representatives (ex: sophomores vote for sophomore representatives). Due to COVID, Mr. Reisberg will meet separately with the class officers to get student input.

Election of Core Officers and Class Representatives

- 1) Any student who desires to run for a class representative position needs to print a form from the school website under “Info.” This form requires the signature of two high school students and three (3) teachers. The form will then be submitted to Mr. Reisberg for final approval. If approved, the student must maintain a 3.0 GPA from the time he or she runs for office until his or her year is completed.
- 2) During a selected period, each candidate running for office may give an election speech with a time limit of four minutes.
- 3) An election for the class representatives will take place during homeroom on the next consecutive school day. Students will vote by ballot in their homerooms. Students only vote for representatives within their own grades.

SCA ELECTION GUIDELINES

Positions

To be eligible, the students must display examples of leadership qualities listed below:

- Good grades
- Faithful in schoolwork
- No major discipline issues
- Minimum number of discipline issues
- An example of leadership
- A student in good standing in all matters

If desired, SCA Student Body candidates may run for a Class Officer position if they do not win their first election. Complete an SCA Student Body Candidacy Form and submit to Mr. Reisberg **by September 11, 2020.**

SCA Class Officers – Grades 6-12 will each elect a Class President and Vice President. These officers will meet with Mr. Reisberg as class representatives. They may also hold their own meetings within their grade. Officers should maintain a 3.0 grade average throughout the school year. If an officer drops below 3.0, he or she will be on probation for an academic quarter to bring grades back up. If unsuccessful, he or she will need to step down. Complete an SCA Class Representative Candidacy Form and submit to Mr. Reisberg **by September 11, 2020**.

- An example of leadership
- A student in good standing in all matters
- Reaching out to help other students
- Promoting a positive attitude and school spirit

Posters

If you are a candidate for an SCA Class President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, or Chaplain position (grades 6-12), you may make an election poster that will be displayed in the hallways. Submit posters to Mr. Reisberg **by Friday, September 11, 2020** for approval. **All posters must be 9x17 or smaller.** Mr. Reisberg will hang the posters on the walls in the hallways.

Speeches

SCA Speech Day is Friday, September 18, 2020 in each homeroom. We will be on an adjusted schedule. Candidates for President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Chaplain have a two to three-minute speech time limit. Speech Tips - Give your name, grade, experience (does not have to be tied to the school), and vision/goals for the position.

Election Day

SCA Election Day is Monday, September 21, 2020 in secondary homerooms. Students will select the President and Vice President for their class (grade) only. That day, each class will also choose a secretary, treasurer, and chaplain. These three positions will be class officers but the President and Vice-President from each class will serve on the SCA and meet with Mr. Reisberg..

Some meetings will be comprised of the SCA core officers and the 9th – 12th grade Presidents and vice-Presidents. Some meetings will be comprised of the SCA core officers and the President and Vice-Presidents from the 6th-12th grade

SCA Events, Activities, and Duties

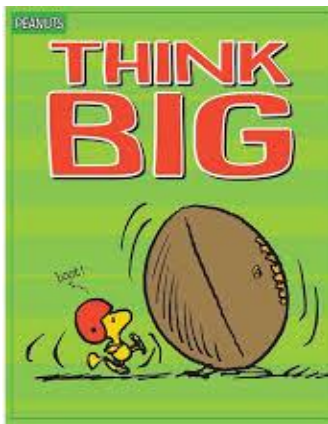
